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Congress is set to use a legislative procedure called “reconciliation” to extend massive tax cuts for billionaires that were enacted in 2017 and are set to expire on December 31. To help pay for these tax cuts, which will cost an estimated \$4.5 trillion over ten years, Congress will likely seek to cut \$50 billion from federal employee pay and benefits.
